# What is “Stopping?”



- The term "stopping" shall mean any halting, even momentarily of a vehicle, whether occupied or not

# What is “Standing?”



- The term "standing" shall mean the stopping of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, [*otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers*]

# What is “Parking?”



- "Parking" shall mean the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, [*otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers*].
-

Stopping, Standing, and  
Parking are the same...  
— halting your vehicle

The difference is the activity you can perform in each  
parking zone

# No Stopping Zone



- You cannot stop temporarily to drop off or pick up passengers or things in a NO Stopping Zone

# No Standing Zone



- You can stop temporarily in a No Standing Zone to drop off or pick up a passenger... BUT, no things [personal property]



# No Parking Zone



- You can stop temporarily in a No Parking Zone to pick up or drop off people and things [personal property]

# Larry's Tips

- Never halt your chariot in a no stopping zone
- The defense to a no standing ticket is that you stopped temporarily to drop off or pick up a person
- The defense to a no parking ticket is that you stopped temporarily to drop off or pick up a person and things
- A bus stop is a no standing zone
