

How to Prepare The Best Defense Ever

I took this photograph while I was seated in my truck when a TEA walked up and issued this parking ticket.

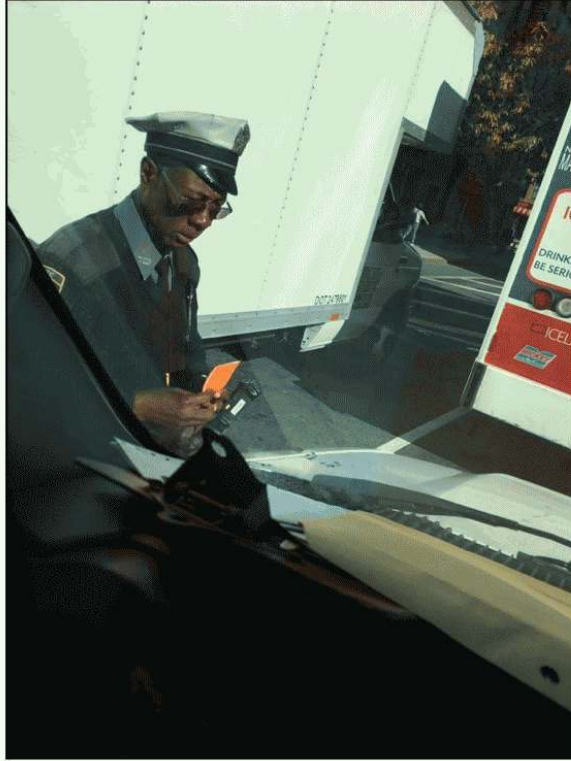
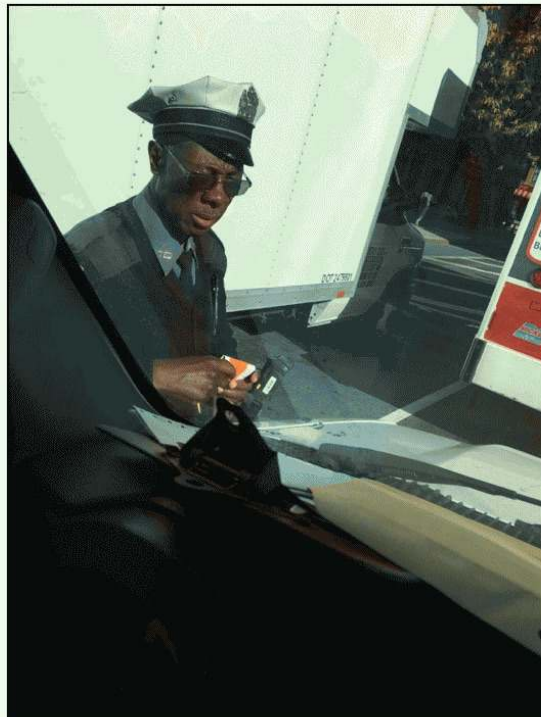

He placed the notice of parking summons on the windshield

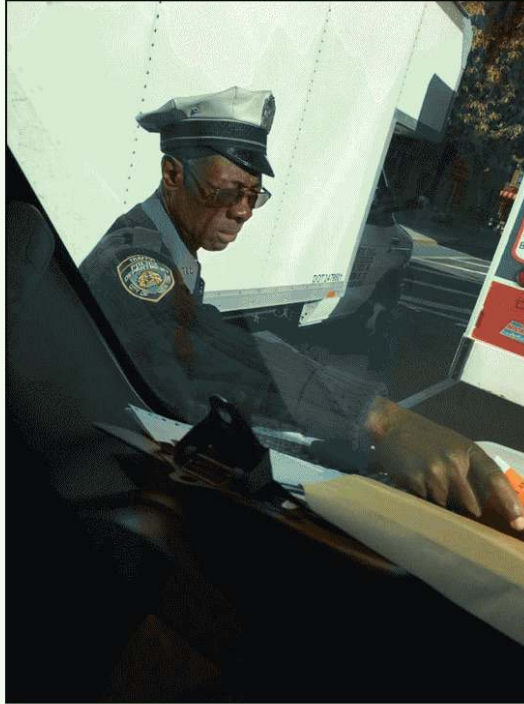
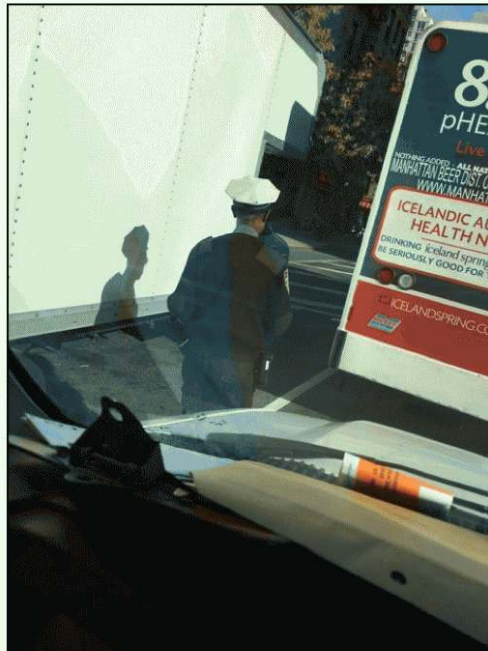


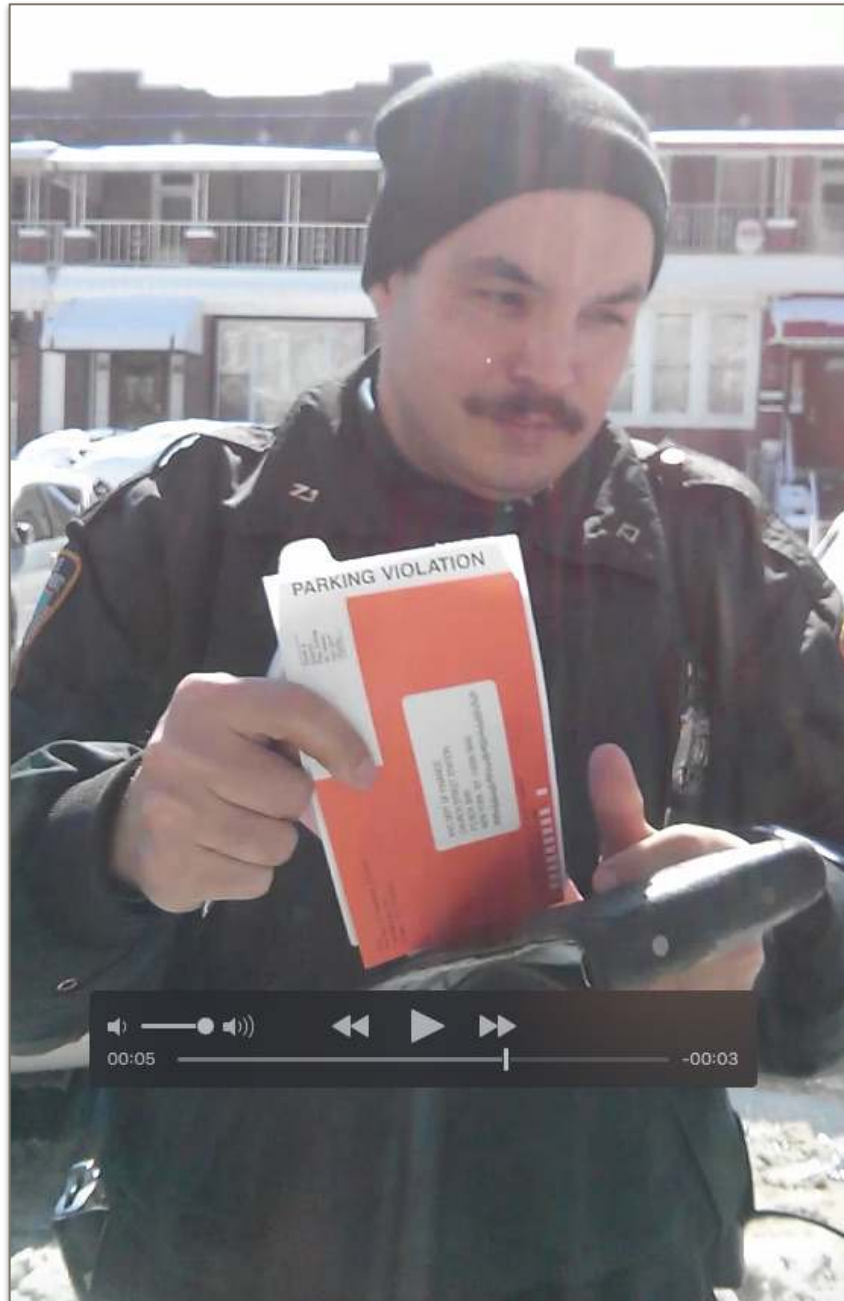
