NEW YORK PARKING TICKET

REQUIRED ELEMENTS

Plate type (for example, PAS, OMT, COM, etc.)

For out-of-state vehicles, the plate type must appear on the plate. If not, the Warrior can enter, NS or NA

Body type (for example, SUBN, MCY, 4DSD, etc.)

For out-of-state vehicles, the body type does not have to an exact match, only reasonably accurate.

The place where the ticket was issued ("front of" or "opposite," etc.), excluding "status" and "equipment" violations

There is a third format to describe a location, "Metes and Bounds." For example, "NS 3rd Avenue, 20 feet East of 45th Street in NYC." This means, North Side of 3rd Avenue, 20 feet East of 45th Street.

Always check to make sure the sides of the streets are described correctly. Is there a North Side of 3rd Avenue? or are the sides, East and West?

The place of occurrence is not a required element in a status or equipment violation

PARKING SIGN RESTRICTIONS

Where there are two signs posted affecting the same area, but with conflicting restrictions, follow the less restrictive sign. Report the conflicting signs by calling 311.

This is a mistake. If there are two conflicting restrictions, follow the most restrictive sign!
